- Implement energy efficient schemes such as efficient heating systems, appropriate insulation, reduce water consumption and energy efficient lighting.
- Ensure noise disturbance is minimalised throughout the business.
- During maintenance operation generation of dust, noise and other potential emissions will be controlled through Risk Assessment to prevent environmental emissions and complaints.
- Provide training and education to our colleagues, members, clients and other interested parties through the active promotion of our performance regarding commitment to protection of the environment in conducting our work and fostering an active commitment to continuous environmental improvement.
- We will consider environmental aspects and impacts at Board and Senior Management levels when making management decisions and changes to any business operation through our 'Management of Change' procedure and other methods.
- Promote and encourage the prevention of pollution and reduction of energy consumption to all colleagues throughout the group encouraging ideas and suggestions from all colleagues.

We are committed to continuous improvement and this will be achieved through:

- The education and training of environmental best practices throughout the group.
- The monitoring of progress and reporting to the senior management team.
- Continued development of our ISO 14001:2015 management systems and implementation at all Company Shop Superstores.
- Internal and external auditing of our environmental systems and procedures.
- We will set environmental objectives which will be approved at Director level and monitored to ensure suitability and effectiveness.
